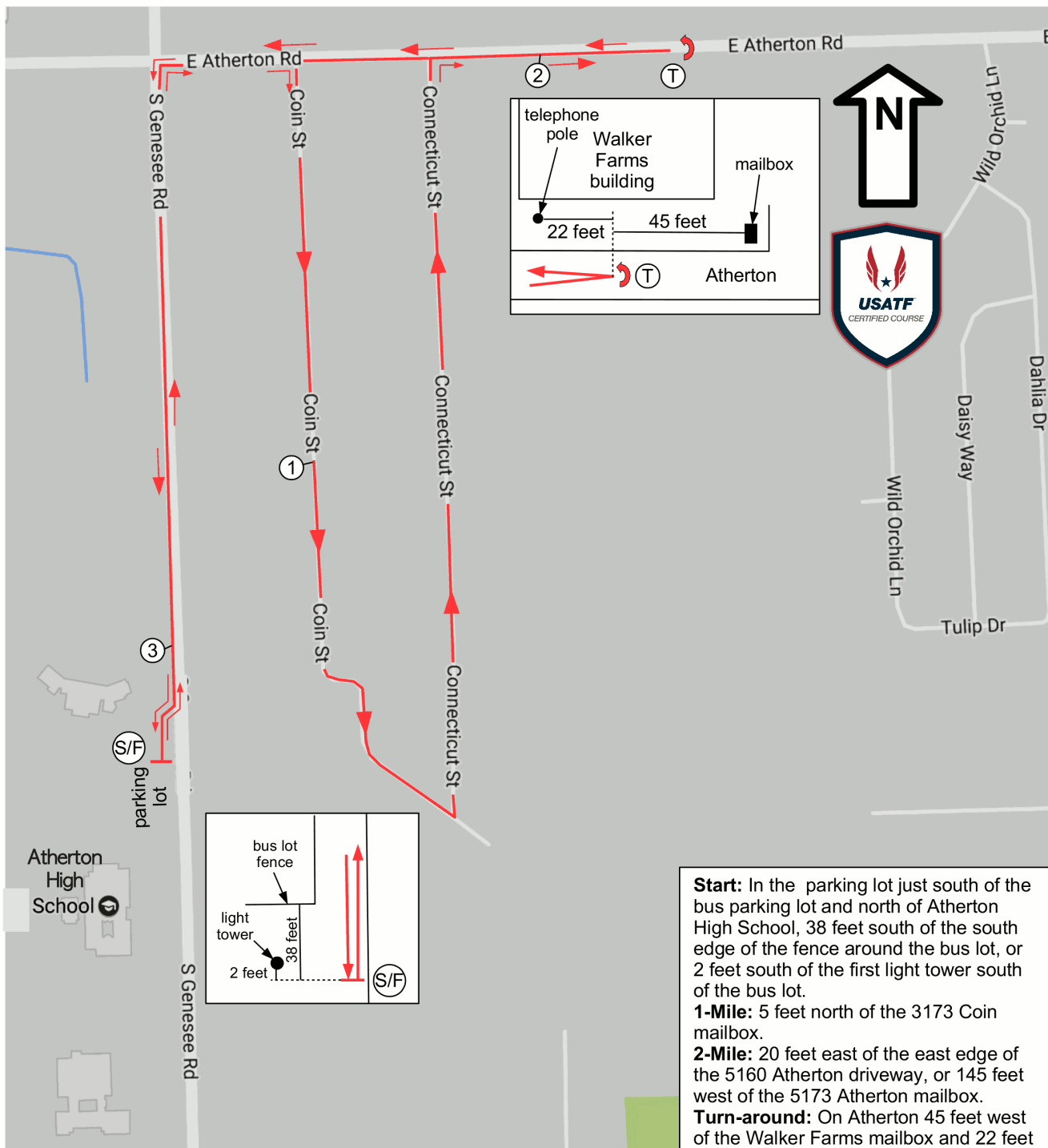

the shortest possible route.

Start: In the parking lot just south of the bus parking lot and north of Atherton High School, 38 feet south of the south edge of the fence around the bus lot, or 2 feet south of the first light tower south of the bus lot.
1-Mile: 5 feet north of the 3173 Coin mailbox.
2-Mile: 20 feet east of the east edge of the 5160 Atherton driveway, or 145 feet west of the 5173 Atherton mailbox.
Turn-around: On Atherton 45 feet west of the Walker Farms mailbox and 22 feet east of the telephone pole at the west end of the Walker Farms building.
3-Mile: 28 feet south of the 3243 Genesee mailbox.
Finish: Same as start.
